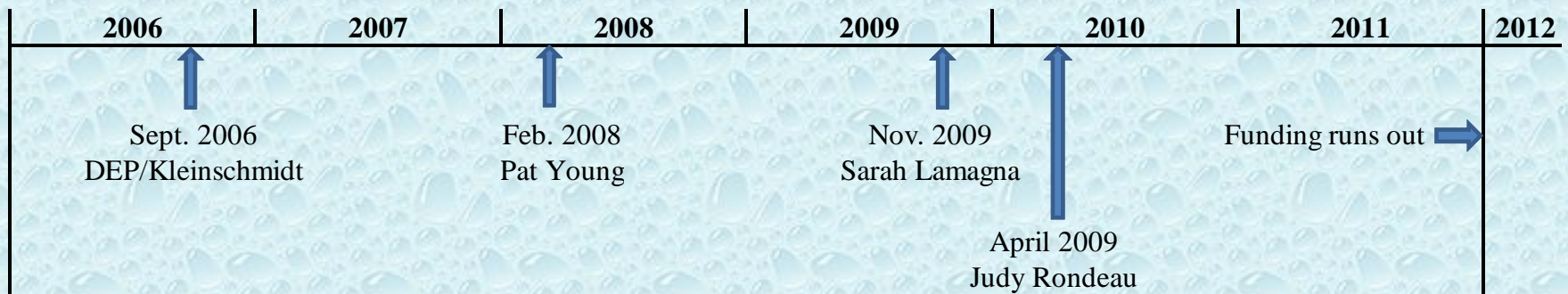


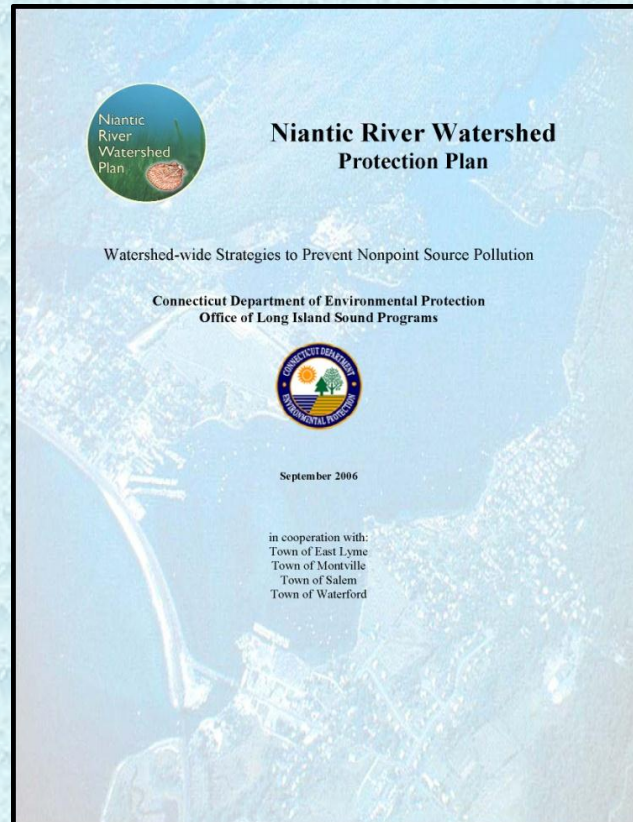
Niantic River Water Quality
